Ajay Kottapalli is currently a tenured Associate Professor and Chair of Bioinspired MEMS and Biomedical Devices Group at the University of Groningen. Since 2018, Ajay is also a Research Affiliate with MIT Sea Grant at Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Prior to this, Ajay worked as a Principal Research Scientist at the Singapore-MIT Alliance for Research and Technology (SMART), Singapore. Ajay Kottapalli published about 100 peer-reviewed papers, edited 2 books and held 3 patents (one of which is granted) in MEMS sensor technology. In 2018, Ajay was awarded the top 10 innovators under 35 in Asia Pacific by the MIT Technology Review, which is a hallmark achievement of his research career. He is an Editorial Board Member of IEEE Sensors Journal and was one of the <u>outstanding reviewers of the year 2016</u> for the Biomimetics and Bioinspiration journal. In 2022, he was awarded the <u>European research council (ERC) Starting</u> <u>Grant</u> of 1.5 mil Euros. He is also the scientific founder of <u>Sencilia</u>, a Medtech start-up which spun out of the research conducted in his group.
